Vide reference 1st cited every Owner/Builder/Authorized representative who has obtained No Objection Certificate for Occupancy under section 13 of Telangana Fire Services Act, 1999 and Rule 15 of Telangana Fire and Emergency Operations and Levy of Fee Rules, 2006 should apply before the competent authority for the Renewal No Objection Certificate after completion of validity with duly remitting the user charges as per G.O. Ms. No.71 Home (Prisons-A) Department, Dated: 01-04-2010.

2. Vide reference G.O.Ms.No.56, 2nd read above, the Principal Secretary to Government of Telangana State, Hyderabad is issued a G.O. on Setbacks and Retrofitting of Fire Safety installations in the existing school buildings as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, dated 13-04-2009 in W.P.No.483 of 2004 by taking Expert Committee Report. The Chief Secretary to Government has convened a meeting with all the concerned on 12-06-2019 on the Fire Safety issues in Schools and decided to issue guidelines on the issues of Fire Safety in the Schools. The Director General, Telangana State Disaster Response & Fire Services Department has also furnished his remarks to Government.

- Government after careful consideration of the decisions taken in the meeting 3. convened by the Chief Secretary to Government on 12-06-2019 and also further remarks of the Director General, Telangana State Disaster Response & Fire Services Department and in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its Judgment dated: 13-04-2009 in W.P. No.483 of 2004, hereby order that, all Schools existing before the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order i.e., dated: 13-04-2009, shall follow the Fire Safety norms as recommended by the Expert Committee as details in the Annexure-I appended to this order, for the purpose of obtaining the affiliation/recognition. Further Self Certification forms shall be submitted by the Schools for the purpose of affiliation/recognition to the authority concerned of Education Department, in the proforma prescribed at Annexure-I appended, duly marking a copy to the jurisdictional Divisional Fire Officer. The Officers of Telangana State Disaster Response & Fire Service will conduct surprise inspections randomly and if any deviations from Self Certification forms are noticed, the same will be intimated to the concerned authority of Education Department recommending for the cancellation of the affiliation/recognition.
- 4. Further, all Schools constructed after the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated: 13-04-2009 shall follow the Safety norms of National Building Code of India. The Telangana State Disaster Response & Fire Services Department will issue Fire No Objection Certificate (NOC) for those schools which come within the purview of Section 13 (1) of Telangana Fire Service Act 1999, that is, Schools which more than 500 Sq.Mtrs in Plot area or 6 Mtrs and above in height duly following the norms of National Building Code of India.
- 5. Vide reference 3rd cited, the Central Board of Secondary Education had Extension of Provisional Affiliation to the above said School with the Board for its Secondary School Examination for a period of five year(s) w.e.f. 01-04-2007 to 31-03-2012 in the subjects in which the School already stands affiliated, subject to the fulfillment of the conditions.
- 6. Vide reference 4th cited, the management was paid Gram Panchyath Tax on 28-03-2005 in the name of VRS Vignana Jyothi School to G.P. Pragathinaar, Qutbullapur Mandal, R.R. District.
- 7. Vide reference 5th cited, the Principal of VRS Vignana Jyothi School, Bachupally (Village & Mandal), Medchal District is requested to certify Annexure-I.
- 8. In view of the above matters and as per reference G.O. 2nd cited, it is decided that those schools which are recognized before the date: 13-04-2009 they need not to take Fire NOC. Even though, the management proposed to provide all the mandatory fire safety measures as per National Building Code of India and maintain with good working condition at all the time and Further Self Certification forms shall be submitted by the Schools for the purpose of affiliation/recognition to the authority concerned of Education Department, in the proforma prescribed at Annexure-I.
